Lowy's Moving Service Delivers 578 Pounds of Food

Lowy's Moving Service of Neptune has instituted "Move for Hunger" to help collect food for the FoodBank of Monmouth and Ocean Counties.

Keith Lowy, president of Lowy's Moving Service, recently delivered 578 pounds of food to the FoodBank.

Customers are asked to donate food which will be moved by Lowy's to the FoodBank. There is no cost to the customer and in many cases, can alleviate the concern of the customer as to how to dispose of accumulated food items.

"I think most people want to do the right thing, but sometimes they just need a little help in doing it. That is where Move for Hunger comes in," Lowy said. "It's a great time to ask for dona-

tions because people are literally cleaning out everything to move."

Both Keith and his brother, Stephan, chief executive officer of Lowy's, have been involved in community service all of their lives. Their parents taught them early on how important it is to give back to the community. "Move for Hunger" is a direct result of that learning experience.

The Lowys would like to see this program become a nationwide effort.

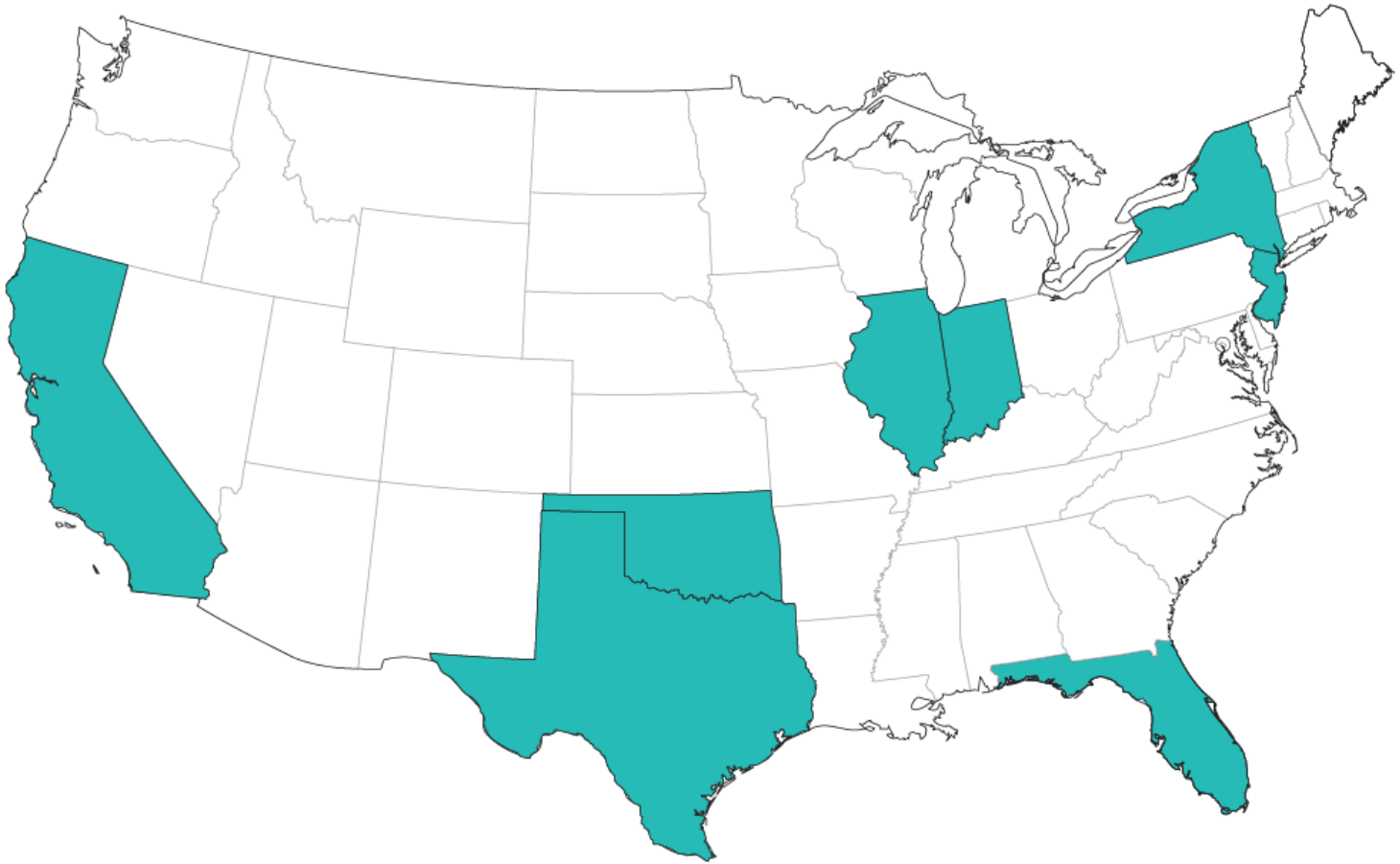
"We are proud of the effort of the Lowy Family and see "Move for Hunger" as the perfect example of people working together to

How It Works

1 THE DROP

Once a new property joins Move For Hunger, we will contact you to schedule a convenient time to drop off food collection bags.



3 KEEPING SCORE!

Move For Hunger will provide you with a Community Donation Form. We ask that you please keep a tally of how many bags you pick up from each property.

A 'DONATION RECEIPT' form from Move For Hunger. The form includes fields for 'Company Making Delivery', 'City', 'State', 'Delivery Date', and 'Quantity'. It also has a table for tracking donations with columns for 'Quantity', 'Weight (lbs)', and 'Food Bank/Partner'. The form is titled 'DONATION RECEIPT' and includes instructions: 'Use this form to track the amount of food collected from each Apartment community. Drop off the donations to the local Food Bank where a weight receipt will be provided.'

2 THE PICKUP

We encourage properties to let bags accumulate before requesting a pickup. On average, we've seen 3-8 bags per month. Properties will contact Move For Hunger when they are ready for a pickup, and we will then coordinate with your team to schedule a pickup within 30 days of this request.



4 WEIGHT RECEIPT

Deliver the food to your designated food bank, where they will provide you with a weight receipt. Send the receipt to receipt@moveforhunger.org. This helps us track how much food you've collected and the impact you're making!

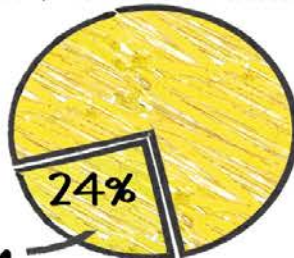
